RE: IA-03 Survey Highlights

Zach Nunn has a double-digit lead in the IA-03 Republican primary race. Recent survey data shows that in a three-way match-up, Zach Nunn gets 24% of the vote, with Mary Ann Hanusa at 13% and Nicole Hasso at 3%. Six-out-of-ten primary voters (60%) are undecided or don't know. Nunn has a double-digit advantage in Dallas and Warren Counties and a 24-point lead in Polk – a county which includes nearly half of all GOP primary voters.

Nunn maintains a nearly 2:1 advantage over his nearest challenger among very Conservative Republicans (which make up over half of the likely primary voter universe) and has an 8-point lead among somewhat Conservative Republicans, though majorities of both groups are undecided. Nunn also leads by ten points among Trump supporters.

In a general election matchup, Nunn holds incumbent Cindy Axne to just 46%. In a head-to-head race against Axne, Nunn trails by only 4% (42% Nunn/46% Axne) and runs stronger among Republicans than either Hanusa or Hasso against the incumbent. In a district that Trump won in 2020 by less than one percentage point – fielding a candidate who motivates GOP voters to turnout is key – and Nunn does that better than any other Republican in the race.

Survey Methodology. This survey was conducted by telephone using IVR methodology, September 9, 2021. A total of N=1,000 IVR interviews were conducted.
